1.) Report from Stephanie re: any recent Board action that would be of interest to the Program Committee

Since Stephanie was absent, no report was given.

2.) Discuss the make-up of the Committee based on the requirements as outlined in the By-Laws:

The Committee is anxious to see who the Board will appoint to replace current members Stephen Yoder and Jahfree Lambo.

3.) Recently there have been some issues with some DJs not keeping their annual membership dues current. The Board has sent this issue back to the Program Committee "for clarification".

After discussion, the Program Committee makes the following recommendation to the Board of Directors:

- Whereas every DJ puts in at least 1 hour at home for every hour that they are on the air (many times 2-3 hours at home per 1 on-air hour), and

- Whereas most, if not all DJs spend their own money acquiring music for on-air presentation (this could be purchase of actual CDs, LPs, mp3s, etc. or subscriptions to Spotify, Pandora, Amazon Music, etc.), and

- Whereas attracting listeners is mainly done by providing content that they wish to listen to,

We, the Program Committee recommend that, while membership in KBRP would still be mandatory for DJs, the cost should be waived as a symbol of appreciation and acknowledgement of the time, money, and energy the DJs put in to making KBRP successful. We suspect that those DJs who currently pay more than the \$5/month minimum will continue to do so.

3.) Fred Miller weekly show?

Fred is reassessing whether or not he wants to get tied down to a weekly commitment since he just recently retired. He said he will continue to think about it.

4.) DJs in training: Cindy Anderson (½ hour medical talk show), Erika Lannom (music show), Miranda Murphy (2-hour indie, alt-rock music show aimed at younger audiences than our current programming appeals to)

5.) Microphone issues in Studio A.

What at first appeared to be a possibly faulty microphone, seems to have actually been a faulty patch cord between the microphone preamp and the DJ mixer board. This is something of a relief in that the microphone costs \$400 and the patch cord costs \$20.
