

DJ Trainee Overview: Training typically takes two or three 1.5- 2 hour sessions and the time it takes to make your 30 minute demo show for the Programming Committee to approve.

In order to be certified as a programmer, and have a new program approved, the trainee must:

- Be familiar with the Main Mixer & understand its function.
- Understand DJ equipment including DJ Mixer, CD Players & computer/software (turntables & cassette deck if needed).
- Must have a good understanding of how to troubleshoot any equipment problems that may arise.
- Know the required elements for a program (Station Ids, Announcements, etc)
 - Create a thirty-minute demo for the programming committee that demonstrates an understanding of the equipment & required elements of a program.
- Written test
